Alzheimer's Association Basics Card

The "Alzheimer's Association Basics Card" is a two-sided informational card that gives a concise overview of Alzheimer's and the Association. The front features information and statistics about Alzheimer's disease. The back lists a number of ways the Association provides support and tells how individuals can get involved. 50 cards per pack.

10 Warning Signs of Alzheimer's Card

"10 Warning Signs of Alzheimer's Disease" is a duofold informational card that describes the difference between normal forgetfulness and dementia. 50 cards per pack.

Principles for a Dignified Diagnosis Card

This two-sided card statement was written by people with dementia on the subject of the Alzheimer's disease diagnosis experience. The card explains how to deal with some of the challenges the medical community faces when talking with those affected by Alzheimer's disease. 50 cards per pack.

Early-Onset Alzheimer's Brochure

"Early-onset Alzheimer's" is a brochure for the person living with early-onset Alzheimer's. It suggests how to approach feelings, family, friends, job, money matters, well-being and future plans. 50 brochures per pack.

"Legal Plans" is a brochure with recommendations for assisting the caregiver and the person with dementia in making legal arrangements. It offers the basics on what legal capacity is, what different legal documents mean, how to find a lawyer and the terms the lawyer may use. It offers a checklist for preparing to meet with a lawyer, as well as key issues to discuss during the meeting. 50 brochures per pack.

Personal Care Brochure

"Personal Care" is a brochure that covers ways to assist a person with dementia with his or her changing personal care needs, including bathing, dental care, dressing, eating, grooming and toileting. 50 brochures per pack.
